Evergreen Marine Corporation has announced it will become a bolero.net user.

A joint venture between the international logistics and financial communities, bolero.net attempts to standardize the electronic transmission of documents and data between all parties in the international trade chain.

The Evergreen Group, based in Taipei, has a fleet of 118 container ships totaling more than 300,000 teus, providing international liner services in 68 countries.
